*Layla: What does veganism mean to you as a vegan?*

*Emeline: To me it's mostly about the animals because I really love animals so I can't see myself just eating them and I don't want to be a part of the meat and dairy industry.*

I also spoke to Greg.

*Layla: So what is your favourite vegan dish to cook?*

*Greg: I like making the same food that I used to eat when I was a child but vegetarian and vegan versions of it, for example pie and mash.*

Mash is a food dish made out of boiled potatoes that are crushed and mashed together. It is clear that to these people the idea of eating meat is weird. But I also wanted to hear the thoughts of a meat eater. Outside a popular burger restaurant in London, Chelsey spoke about how she chose to eat certain meats because they were better for you.

*Chelsey: I'd rather eat Turkey over chicken because it's leaner and its better for you and definitely white meat over red meat*

Chelsey prefers to buy organic meat instead of mass-produced meat. It is a way of supporting local farmers instead of being an unethical choice.

*Layla: Why do you buy organic meat?*

*Chelsey: They're a lot nicer to the animals and you're supporting local farmers.*
