Samuel wants to see a change in how homelessness is dealt with in Britain.

Samuel: I want more help to be given to people who are in that situation, because a lot of homeless people are very intelligent and they also have a lot of skills, which they don't use and it kind of really goes to waste.

According to *Homeless Link*, the most common reason for a person becoming homeless, is the breakdown of a relationship.
