<p>Samuel is an artist exhibiting at the event and who used to be homeless.</p> <p><i>In what way have you been affected by homelessness in the past?</i></p> <p><i>Samuel: Well I used to be homeless a couple of years ago for a few years, between 3 and 5 years but thankfully I started doing photography</i></p> <p>Samuel told me how photography changed his life and was the reason he was no longer homeless.</p> <p><i>Samuel: It was majorly through photography that gave me the kick up the backside to help myself get out of being homeless, get a job, get a place and do more exhibitions for my photography and my art</i></p> <p>Art is also being used as a way to help homeless people. Samuel wants to see a change in how homelessness is dealt with in Britain.</p> <p><i>Samuel: I want more help to be given to people who are in that situation, because a lot of homeless people are very intelligent and they also have a lot of skills, which they don't use and it kind of really goes to waste.</i></p> <p>According to <i>Homeless Link</i>, the most common reason for a person becoming homeless, is the breakdown of a relationship.</p> <p>And finally, chicken nugget tweet breaks records</p> <p>A tweet from a teenager asking a US fast food chain for a year's supply of chicken nuggets has become the most retweeted ever. The fast food chain replied to Carter Wilkerson's tweet saying he needed 18 million retweets to get his wish. After only two days, Carter's tweet had achieved 1 million retweets!
