- **First up, Wildfires in California**

Two weeks ago, wildfires began in California, forcing thousands to leave their homes. Strong winds and a dry weather caused the fire to spread very quickly. When the winds dropped after one week, the fire crews were able to make progress fighting the fires.

Listen to what Ken Pimlott, Chief of California Firefighters, said to ABC News:

*Ken Pimlott: "These fires are just literally burning faster than firefighters can run"*

The wildfires destroyed California's wine producing area and other parts of the state. At the time of this recording a total of 40 people have been killed and many are still missing.

*Presenter: So, Mark, why did you create this school Diner's Project?*

*Mark: I thought that there was a space in education to teach young people life skills and cooking.*

Mark says that he saw a space in education. By that he means he saw an opportunity gap in education for children. He had problems himself when he was younger.

*I got removed from three schools and grew up in children's homes and I found a lot of students who are like me, who education wasn't really for.*

Now Mark wants to teach children in the same position that they can succeed even if they don't like school that much.

*Mark: I think that it's really really important that there is nothing that they cannot do. And then they prove it to themselves by doing an event like this.*

I also spoke to one of the pupils.

*Paisley: Hello I'm Paisley Perry and I'm 15 years old.*

Paisley thought it was a great experience:

*Paisley: A great experience for young children. And I've definitely learnt how to cooperate with everybody else in the team.*

*Eminem: "It's like we take a step forwards, then backwards  
But this is his form of distraction  
Plus, he gets an enormous reaction  
When he attacks the NFL so we focus on that  
Instead of talking Puerto Rico or gun reform for Nevada  
All these horrible tragedies and he's bored and would rather..."*

Recently, rapper Eminem stunned social media and his fans with 'The Storm'. 'The Storm' was a four-minute freestyle attack on President Donald Trump that was recorded for the BET Hip Hop Awards. During this rap, Eminem accused Trump of hypocrisy, racism and disrespect of military veterans.
