Before watching the film: write as much as you can for 2-3 minutes in silence

Your writing is just to organize your thoughts – nobody will read what you write.

After watching: discuss in groups of 4-5

1. At the beginning, what is the first sound we hear in the movie and what does that make you feel?
2. Name some things that love is, according to Lola?
3. What do you think love is, according to her mother?
4. What is the mother like?
5. Describe the two different groups of friends that Lola has.
6. Lola talks about being in charge. Do you think she is in charge of her life or not? Explain your answer.
7. Do you think the mothers acts as she should? Explain your answer. If you think she should have done anything differently, how and why?
8. After what happened to Lola's friends, do you think she changed? How and why?



After watching: be creative!

1. Write an essay on peer pressure. For instance, what are the pros and cons of peer pressure? As yourself or a fiction person, describe and discuss some of your memories of group pressure.
2. Make a group poster to hang in the class room on the theme: "what love is"
