After watching – talk in pairs or small groups

1. Describe a normal workday for the main character.
2. Describe the beginning and the end of the film.
3. How would you describe the café/restaurant where she works?
4. What is so special about the table?
5. Pick three of the customers and describe them in detail: what do they look like; clothes, age, what do you think they do for a living; what would you guess is their age, what do they order, how do they speak, where do they live.... etc.
6. Talking about the waitress's job, what would you say are the positives and negatives? Would you like to have her job or a similar one? Why? Why not?
7. There was one man who was talking on the phone and then said he would like something "off the menu" – what was he implying? What did the waitress answer?
8. Try to recall and describe the scene with the deaf person. What happened?
9. There was one couple where the woman kept telling the man about salt. How would you describe their relationship? What clues are there in the film that make you think so?
10. What do you think the manager means when he says: "Wish you weren't leaving"?
11. The title of the film is Lazy Susan. Do you think this describes the main character well or not? Explain your answer.
