### Cups and robbers

#### Before watching

Discuss in class:

What do you think the title means? Why is the movie called “Cups and Robbers”, do you think and not “Cops and Robbers”?

#### While watching

- Notice the music during the movie. How does it change along with the story?

#### After watching

Discuss in groups of 3-4:

- Only three of the robbers were masked in the beginning of the movie. Why do you think the fourth robber was unmasked? Later, the other three take off their masks. Why do you think they decided to do that?
- What do you think the café staff is thinking when they realize the robbers are going to serve the guests? Why do you think the robbers decided to work instead of sending the guests off?
- At first, the robbers seem to struggle a lot with serving the guests. What do you think changes that? Why do you think they start enjoying what they do and become good at it?
- In the beginning of the movie, the robbers, when working as robbers, seem uncoordinated and not really cooperating. By the end of the movie, they cooperate really well and they work smoothly together. Why do you think that is? Do you think they can apply the positions they had within their group as robbers, on their jobs in the café?
- What happens with the victims? Do you think they change from this experience? Why/Why not? What do you think they think of the robbers?
- What do you think the robbers and the café staff think when they realize they are being robbed – again?

- Choose the statement/-s you think is/are more fitting to describe the movie and present some arguments to why you think so;
  - This is a movie...
    - ... about clumsy robbers
    - ... about working in a café
    - ... about the dynamics in a group of people
    - ... about enjoying what you do
    - ... about ...
