Discuss in class:

What do you think the title refers to? Have you heard the phrase "one small step" before? Where?


While watching

• This movie takes place in the U.S.A. Try to notice differences in the environments where the movie takes place and environments that you know from where you live.

After watching

Discuss in groups of 3-4:

- What kind of neighborhood do you think Dasani lives in? Is it poor, middleclass or rich? What makes you think that? Do you think she feels safe in the neighborhood? Why/why not?
- How is Dasani's school? How is her home? How is childcare? What differences did you notice between the environments in the movie and the ones you are used to from your own life?
- How is Dasani as a person? Can you try to describe her using adjectives?
- How is Dasani's family? What does her mother work with? How is her mom? What do you think happened with her father? How are her siblings, Avi and Lance?
- What signs do you think Dasani and her mom were making? What was her mom going to use them for?
- How is Dasani's mom planning for them to celebrate Avi's birthday? How do they end up celebrating it?
- Why do you think Avi doesn't want to go to school? Why does she run away?
- What happens when Dasani's card doesn't work when she pays for lunch? Why do you think it's so important for her that the card works?
- What do you think has happened with Dasani's mom? Why isn't she coming home? Why isn't any adult coming by to take care of the kids? Why isn't anyone calling to tell them what has happened?

- What do you think happens after the movie has ended? What do you think happens with Dasani? Does she go on the field trip? Does the mother come back again? What happens with Avi? What happens with Lance?
