Vici: It's impossible to play casually, like you know, a couple of hours a day and get to the end game, you know the real end game stuff. I mean, I don't play so much anymore but at the height of my sort of like you know passion, as it were, I played for about 10 hours a day, probably, yeah.

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Vici: Probably quite a while. I went to the midnight launch of *Wrath of the Lich King* and I went to the midnight launch in London, got home, installed the game and didn't stop playing for about, two days maybe? Two or three days, because I was so excited about this thing being brought out. I was on a buzz and I got the collector's edition or whatever and I, yeah, literally about two or three days. I think I might have actually fell asleep on my computer like...quite bad.

It's a very addictive game. The way that it's orchestrated is very addictive. I mean. I play games anyway, I have done all my life, and it's the type of game that you can get incredible into very, very quickly. And just for the fact that, you know, everything, my whole social life ended up being based around the game. I actually met my ex-boyfriend on there and we were together about three years. We met through the game and we ended up living together and you know, playing the game together and stuff. So, just for the fact that I was fully immersed in it, from a completely you know, social point of view, in fact I loved playing and raiding became like a really big part of my life.

I did astrophysics as a degree and now I'm doing a Masters in game development and I eventually want to work for Blizzard. That's my main, you know, focus, is that, you know, get qualified, get in to game development and eventually apply to work for World of Warcraft.
