RocktheVote cares less about who wins and more about making sure young people's voices are heard.

RocktheVote have teamed up with national athletes, such as the Women's National Basketball Player Association, to get their message heard.

Rebekkah Brunson, part of the Minnesota lynx says...

REBEKKAH BRUNSON: *I think it is important to use your voice, I think it is important to stand up for the things you want to see happen in the communities around you.*

In the last election, 60% of the young voters registered were first time voters recruited by RocktheVote.

Will they surpass that number this year?

### **Now, have you ever received unwanted sexual attention at school?**

Meet BelEve. They're a charity supporting young women. Here in the UK they've started a campaign called 'It is that deep', all about the "low level" sexual harassment that happens in school that often goes undetected.

MARSHA POWELL: *Sexual harassment is unwanted. So, it could be a stare. It could be someone touching you physically. It could be sexting.*

I spoke to Marsha, one of the founding members of the campaign, over the phone. She told me what sexual harassment can include.

KATE HOLLAND: So how do you gain the confidence to speak out against unwanted sexual harassment?

MARSHA POWELL: I think it's about education. It's about giving girls an opportunity to gain knowledge and experience around what is available to them if it's something that's happening to them.

Teenager Naaisa says we should all learn about sexual harassment at school.

NAAISA: *I think sexual harassment should be an element of education whereby boys are educated about what it really is, because one girl might like a boy calling her sexual names, but another girl might not like it. Boys should be educated on not doing certain things unless they've received that consent.*

Naaisa says it's all about consent. Consent means agreeing or disagreeing to something, and most importantly only doing what feel comfortable with.
