LGBTQ+ Loneliness

Young LGBTQ+ people are twice as likely as their peers to feel lonely and sad during the Coronavirus pandemic.

LGBTQ+ stands for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, and other people who don't identify with being heterosexual.

That statistic is according to the charity *Just Like Us*. Amy Ashenden from the charity says not being able to go to school has a big impact.

Amy Ashenden: If LGBT+ young people are living at home with unaccepting families, they really need to know that school is a safe and welcoming place where they can talk to a teacher if they need help or support.

Jonny is from Manchester. He spoke to us about his mental health during the pandemic.

Jonny: I worry about my mental health every day. I worry about being lonely.

Jonny moved out of his family home at the beginning of the pandemic and has missed their support.

Jonny: Not having that kind of core support from both family and mainly from friends has really affected me.

Elizabeth Milovidov: Babies and toddlers may not always be able to express their consent, even though older children can say yes mom, I want to be a child influencer.

Child influencers can make a lot of money. Some parents of child influencers say they are saving this money for their children when they are older. This is Jaqi Clement, mum of 9-year-old influencer twins Ava and Leah. She spoke to CBS News about what she does with the money they make.

Jaqi Clement: They're getting to keep all their money, which is, which is great. So when they get older, they'll be able to do a lot of stuff with that.

But Elizabeth Milovidov thinks that parents could create an online identity for their child, that they may not want, nor like.
