Entrepreneurship Review found that over half of 18-to 30-year-olds in the UK dream of setting up their own business.

But, in reality, less than 10% actually do. So why is there such a gap between ambition and action? The Review said one key issue was a lack of access to finance and support.

FRED: Yeah, I think it's a scary prospect because it just offers no financial stability.

KATE: That's Fred, who's 23. He's developing an idea to create special shoes which turn the energy in our footsteps into electricity to recharge a mobile phone battery.

KATE: So it's a super green and sustainable idea?

FRED: Yep, that's exactly the purpose of the invention. It's to bypass the use of traditional fossil fuels, and to empower users to generate their own clean electricity.

KATE: What are the advantages of having your own business?

FRED: Well personally, I just really enjoy working my own hours and not having to answer to anyone.

KATE: And what are some of the disadvantages?

FRED: The main disadvantage is not being able to switch off. With a regular 9-to-5 you can shut down your computer once the day is over, enjoy the rest of your evening but if you work for yourself you need to find ways of doing that

KATE: I also spoke to Tabby, who's 22, and founded a clothes upcycling company – during lockdown last year.

Tabby also likes being her own boss but says it's not easy running your own business

TABBY: At this early stage of my business, I'm not earning enough to make it support me. And so I have to take a part time job on top of the full time business, so probably working 13 hours a day

KATE: And what tips would Tabby and Fred give to people looking to become an entrepreneur?

TABBY: The main thing is that you need to be super passionate about what you're going to set up your business in, and it shouldn't just be about making money.

FRED: Don't be scared when things go wrong: take stock, be flexible and try again.
