Did it change the way you think about deafness or hearing impairment?

Bella: Yes, seeing her rehearse without being able to hear or hear the music is really impressive.

I also spoke to 17-year-old, Grace.

Would you like to learn sign language?

Grace: I feel like it would be a really useful and cool skill to be able have. It would be really good if more people could speak sign language.

What do you think about the campaign to make BSL an officially recognised language?

Grace: I think it's really important giving deaf people more access to everything that they should legally have the right to be able to access.
