## A Helping Hand

Now, how far would you drive to help some strangers?

Dan Carrier, a journalist from the Camden New Journal newspaper in London, drove more than 1,500km to deliver donations to Ukrainians in Poland who had escaped the Russian invasion.

I spoke to Dan to find out why he decided to drive to Poland.

*Dan Carrier: We seem to have stumbled from the pandemic into a really serious war right on our doorstep. So as a newspaper reporter, I was interested in going and bearing witness. And also, I had access to a truck and lots of generous friends who could fill it.*

Dan collected items such as clothes, medicines and toys from people in his local area and he was even given a van for his journey.

It took him three days to drive to Boleslaw, a small village near Krakow.

What were people's reactions in Poland when you delivered the donations?

*Dan Carrier: Their reaction was lovely. They said it was really good to know the people in London were thinking of them, and they thought it was nice that we'd driven all that way to say bello and bring them lots and lots of really good stuff.*

Before his return drive, Dan picked up 35-year-old Bohdana, a Ukrainian woman who had escaped from Kyiv, and her dog Jack as they needed a lift to the UK.

Her family was waiting for her in London.

What happened when Bohdana was reunited with her family?

*Dan Carrier: Her aunt and her dad and her sister and her mum were waiting for us at my house. I mean, they had rockets flying across the air above their heads while they were*
