But First...

Queen Elizabeth II's death was announced at 6.30pm on Thursday 8th September.

*BBC News clip: This is BBC News from London, Buckingham Palace has announced the death of Queen Elizabeth II*

She had been Queen for over 70 years after her father, King George IV, died in 1952.

The UK entered a 10 day period of grieving after her death and thousands of people waited for hours to see her coffin in London.

Her son Charles, is now king of the UK and he will be ceremonial head of the country.

He said in his first speech as king: *I pay tribute to my Mother's memory and I honor her life of service.*

## What young people think about the Queen's death

Thousands of people gathered outside of Buckingham Palace in London to leave flowers and notes for the Queen.

Buckingham Palace was her official home but she had died in Scotland.

Her body was flown to London a few days after her death.

I went to Buckingham Palace to speak to some young people about the Queen's death.

Sadie, who is 19 years old, told me what she thought.

*Sadie: I think it was quite upsetting, because I'd recently watched a BBC documentary on her life and it was quite sad to see someone so kind and generous pass away. And I think, yeah, she definitely was a role model to all of us.*

Sadie says the Queen was a 'role model' for all of us which means she set an example.

*Kate: What will she be remembered for?*

*Sadie: I think her entire legacy was just kind of kindness like I mean, I think I remember her as a person always being quite, you know, kind to people. She always respected cultures.*

*Kate: Sadie, what do you think about her son Charles becoming king?*

*Sadie: I just don't like him at all, in all honesty. And I remember, like as soon as I saw him being crowned king, I just got so worried, like, I'm so worried for the future.*

I also spoke to Anaya, who is 14 years old, and asked her why she was there.
