Paintings across Europe attacked in climate crisis protests

World famous artworks by Monet, Picasso and Botticelli have been attacked by protestors in recent weeks.

Activists from the group Just Stop Oil have thrown tinned soup and other liquids at paintings in galleries across Europe.

Phoebe Plummer, the 21-year-old who threw soup on Vincent Van Gogh's Sunflowers at a gallery in London, said in a video published on the Guardian newspaper website:

Phoebe: What is worth more art or life for one? Is it worth more than food, worth more than justice?

The protestors want to raise awareness of just how harmful fossil fuels are to the planet. The paintings were all protected by glass and not damaged by the campaigners.

Young people are drinking less alcohol

Buying alcohol is illegal until you are 18 in many European countries, including in the UK.

But these days, lots of young people who reach the age of 18 are rejecting alcohol.

According to research from BMC Public Health, a research journal, around one in three young people under the age of 26 call themselves 'non drinkers' and do not drink any alcohol.

I spoke to some young people to find out more.

Daniella is a 24-year-old who lives in London. I asked her if she drinks.

Daniella: I do drink alcohol, but not very often. I just don't like the taste, so it's not something that I really want.

Kate: Do you think fewer young people are drinking alcohol these days?

Daniella: I do think young people are drinking less alcohol in general because personally I've experienced a lot of people not been too shocked by me just choosing not to drink at events.

Kate: Are there enough alternatives out there for people who don't drink like yourself, Daniella?

Danielle: There's not a lot of choice from bars and restaurants, but there are specialist places popping up which are completely sober. But that's kind of difficult when you go with friends who drink because they're missing out on the experience that they want. So I think I think there definitely could be more places that have non-alcoholic drinks.

I also spoke to Sean Spooner who is 26, but hasn't drunk any alcohol since he was 21 years old.

Kate: Do you think fewer young people are drinking alcohol compared to a few years ago, Sean?

Sean: It seems to me that young people are drinking less alcohol than they were before, even compared to when I was, say, 18. It seemed at least, where I was living at the time, everybody would drink, like everybody would go out

two or three nights a week. It would just be the thing you do. But it does seem now that both people my age and younger don't quite look at alcohol in the same way

Kate: Why do you think this is?

Sean: The fact that we can see that alcohol is this thing that in some cases stands at odds with our goals and where we want to get to. I think the access to that information probably plays a role in fewer young people drinking these days.
