Protestors throw soup at paintings

Protestors from the group Just Stop Oil have thrown soup and other liquids at priceless art pieces in galleries across Europe.

Two women threw tomato soup on a painting of sunflowers by Van Gogh at a gallery in London in October.

Their group wants governments around the world to stop supporting fossil fuel companies.

Phoebe Plummer, one of the two protestors who threw the soup, said in a video filmed by the Guardian newspaper:

Are young people starting to reject alcohol ?

Will you drink alcohol when you are legally allowed to?

More and more young people in the UK are rejecting alcohol, even when they are allowed to drink it.

According to BMC Public Health, a research journal, one in three young people under the age of 26 do not drink any alcohol.

A study by the NHS says fewer young people are drinking alcohol because they are more aware of the negative health effects of alcohol.

I wanted to find out if this was true so spoke to some young people to find out more.

Kaci is a 21-year-old university student and I asked her if she drinks alcohol.

Kaci: I do not drink. I do not have any extensive past experiences with drinking and I do not intend to start drinking at any point.

Kate: Why do you not drink alcohol, Kaci?

Kaci: As a generation we are more informed: a mixture of having exposure to the internet from a young age and schools having a push to teach the students of the shortcomings that being a heavy drinker can bring has led to a lot of younger people generally being more health conscious.

Kate: Are there any events for people who don't drink at your university?

Kaci: My university has a society that is just for people who wish to hang out and meet people in a way that does not prioritize drinking.

I spoke to Ed who is 24 years old. He says he drinks much less than he did a few years ago.

Kate: Why are young people drinking less these days, Ed?

Ed: Because it's really, really expensive nowadays to go to a pub. There might be some other bits about alcohol being less glamorised because there's more and more information out there about the health side effects of drinking a lot of alcohol.
