How people in the UK reacted to the war in Ukraine

Many people have been affected by the war in Ukraine this year. According to UNHCR, the United Nations' Refugee Agency, millions of people have now left Ukraine and crossed borders into neighboring countries – such as Poland and Germany.

Back in March, I spoke to 16-year-old Julia. I asked her if she thought that the UK should be doing more to help the refugees.

Julia: You see the EU letting in everyone for three years. No questions asked. And the UK saying only certain people from your family are allowed in, which just seems unfair on all the people in Ukraine who won't have connections in the UK and have nowhere else to go.

I just can't imagine what it's like without any power. It's really hard for us to just continue, isn't it? And we're just carry on with our little lives and this is happening...it's horrendous.

Now, it's been revealed that around one and a half million people in the UK have what's known as long covid. And many of them are young people.

Andrew Gwynne: When my self-isolation period ended and, in theory, I should have been fine to return to work, I found that I couldn't.

That was MP Andrew Gwynne, who back in March told the UK Parliament about his struggles with long covid.

In May, I spoke to Callum O'Dwyer, who suffers from long covid. He is a former engineer who had to change his job because of his health.

Callum: It was about 2 to 3 months on from the initial infection that I realised that things were looking pretty grim. Things were not improving dramatically or in any sort of speed.

But Callum felt hopeful about his future.

Callum: I feel like I'm slowly starting to learn ways of managing, which means that my quality of life will continue to improve.

I hope Callum's recovery is going in the right direction!
