Andrew Tate arrested in Romania

Now, have you heard of Andrew Tate?

He's a former kickboxer who has millions of followers on social media, where he's known for his sexist views.

He's been arrested in Romania and is accused of a number of crimes – including sexual assault and sex- trafficking. Sex trafficking is when people are taken to another country and forced into sex work.

Teachers in the UK are worried that he is still admired by many young men and are teaching pupils that his views are wrong and harmful. Here's headteacher Nick Hewlett talking to the BBC:

Nick Hewlett: These young vulnerable teenagers are in that space listening to people like Andrew Tate and it's having a hugely negative impact on their outlook on life.

But why do so many young men think that Andrew Tate is right? I've been speaking to some teenagers to get their views on this. Here's Honor who is 18 years old. I asked how she first came across Andrew Tate.

Honor: I found out about Andrew Tate through TikTok, as his opinions grew to become more extreme as they started popping up onto my feed page.

Carrie: And why do you think he has such a big following among young men?

Honor: I think he has such a loyal fan base because his views are so extreme. People hide behind him to voice their own opinions.

Honor says that some people think that because Andrew Tate is so popular it's ok to have extreme views like his. I also spoke to university student Ed.

Ed: I think a lot of boys take enjoyment in his opposition to mainstream views and his sort of quite outlandish positions on a lot of things.

Ed says that Andrew Tate says things which are outlandish – extreme views that other people wouldn't dare to say.

Ed: And I think a lot of people find it sort of funny and refreshing in a way.

Carrie: And Honor do you think social media companies should do more to stop these extreme views on their platforms?

Honor: It's hard because of freedom of speech. But perhaps putting more filters on these extremist videos will cause people to stop wanting to post them.

All men nominated at the BRIT awards for Best Artist
