Prince Harry says he felt it would have been wrong for him to have kept his life secret.

He's in a Romanian prison, accused of sexual assault and sex trafficking. Sex trafficking is when people are taken to another country and forced into sex work.

But teachers in the UK are worried that he is still admired by a lot of people and have started holding lessons to teach pupils that his views about women are wrong.

This is headteacher Nick Hewlett talking to the BBC:

Nick Hewlett: The reality is that these young vulnerable teenagers with growing minds are listening to people like Andrew Tate and it's having a hugely negative impact on their outlook on life.

I spoke to some young people about why Andrew Tate has such a big audience. Here's 18 year old Honor.

Honor: I found out about Andrew Tate through TikTok, as his opinions grew to become more extreme as they started popping up onto my feed page.

Carrie: And why do you think he has such a big following among young men?

Honor: I think he has such a loyal fan base because his views are so extreme. People hide behind him to voice their own opinions.

Honor says that some people think that because Andrew Tate is so popular it's ok to have extreme views.

I've also been speaking to university student Hector. He says that Andrew Tate appeals to boys who don't have girlfriends.

Hector: Some of his followers may not be very successful with women, and it's important for them that their lack of success is the women's fault and not their own.

Carrie: Hector says that some young men think that life is more difficult for them now because women have more rights than they used to.
