The chat platform Discord has delayed plans to verify users' ages after criticism from its community.

It was going to ask some users to provide ID or complete a facial scan to prove their age.

Popular Twitch streamer Alastair, known as Eret, was one of many who raised concerns about how Discord might use the data it collected.

A previous data breach on the platform led to the leaking of seventy-thousand ID photos.

Discord says it's now looking at different ways to verify people's ages.

**BBC News:** Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor, the former Prince Andrew, has been arrested on suspicion of misconduct in public office.

When former Prince Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor was arrested last month, it was headline news across the world.

The arrest was the latest event in the scandal surrounding his relationship with the sex offender Jeffrey Epstein.

Andrew has always said he's done nothing wrong. But the scandal has led to lots of debate about the future of the British Monarchy.

I've been hearing the views of some young people in the UK.

I first spoke to Matthew.

**Matthew:** I feel not very positive feelings towards the monarchy. Especially coming from somewhere like Scotland and having lots of friends from other places like Ireland you kind of hear very bad stories about the things that they do to those countries and I don't like it.

I also spoke to Henry.

**Henry:** I'm personally not a fan. I don't think they do too much for society. You know, you ask people what they do, and I don't think anyone can give you a specific answer. So, I'm not a fan.

**Cary:** And Matthew, do you think Andrew's scandal could be the beginning of the end for the royal family?

**Matthew:** That's a tricky one to say because obviously this is a historic moment. Like, in a few decades time this will be studied as like one of the biggest things to happen to the monarchy in hundreds of years - but also they're such an institution and such a money maker for the UK that everything is going to be done to make sure it's not the end of them but it seems like it should be.

**Cary:** And what do you think Henry?

**Henry:** It does seem like it. I think especially with social media and things like that, inevitably you see that, you know, blue blood isn't a thing. They are just as fallible as anybody.

**Cary:** Matthew, supporters say that the royal family makes money for the UK because of tourism, *and* that they are an important part of the country's history. What do you think about that?

**Matthew:** I mean it's true they are an important part of our history but there are lots of things in history that are important in the sense that they had an impact, but that doesn't necessarily mean that they're good and deserve to stay around.

**Cary:** And what about you, Henry? Do you agree?

**Henry:** France is one of the most visited countries in the world and they famously kill their monarchy so I think maybe instead of the millions we give them we should hire a marketing team instead.
